The Aidoc/SaferMD system enables radiologists to increase MIPS quality measure scores while simplifying data collection. SaferMD’s QCDR is already popular amongst radiologists, offering 19 CMS approved, high priority measures (including eight submeasures) designed specifically for radiologists. These measures are not available in standard registries. Many of SaferMD’s measures measure actionable and critical result reporting performance. Aidoc’s AI system detects critical findings and moves them to the top of the work list. This enables radiologists to view and report critical findings quicker.

For example, in cases of subdural hematoma, Aidoc’s AI system can detect the critical finding and notify the radiologist immediately. This enables the radiologist to interpret the case sooner, send results to the referring clinician faster, and speed up treatment. Simultaneously, Aidoc collects the diagnostic information and time stamps required to report performance on the SaferMD QCDR measure SMD 25.
